MUSIC EDUCATION

We held in-person auditions for three of the five ensembles in our Training Young Musicians program. String Orchestra Workshop (beginning strings) does not require an audition. Debut Youth Orchestra and Aspirante Youth Orchestra (beginning and intermediate level full orchestras) will rehearse on Saturday mornings at Sonoma Academy. Santa Rosa Symphony Youth Orchestra (advanced full orchestra) will rehearse Sunday evenings at Sonoma Country Day School, and Young People's Chamber Orchestra (advanced strings), which is by invitation only, will rehearse at Sonoma State University. The Board proposes the following change :

Change: Article II Membership: Parent Members

Delete the sentence. "Dues shall be waived."

Rationale: We have come to believe that many parents would like to support their children by active involvement in the League. This change reflects our desire to bring them into the League with enhanced commitment as dues-paying members.
